Successful applicants not complying with conditions will have their permits revoked.

**A permit allows you** to access closed roads at restricted times and via identified entry points.

Vehicular access into the CBD will be restricted to permitted vehicles under the following conditions and times:-:

- ♪ *Midnight to 10am open, permit access - (Sat 28 Jan 4am to 7am only);*
- ♪ *10am to 6pm - managed access using marshalls; and*
- ♪ *6pm to midnight – vehicular access with appropriate permit only*

Entry points to the closed road network will be via the following locations

- ♪ *Peel St at White Street*
- ♪ *Peel St at Bourke Street*

**NOTE:** **rigid vehicles are restricted to two axles & < 7 metres long**

Applications will be assessed on a case by case basis and the applicable permit will be granted subject to its conditions being met at all times by the applicant.

**Failure to comply with permit conditions may result in infringements being issued**

A restriction will apply to multiple vehicle permits being issued. Rego's and contact numbers can also be provided on the reverse.
